

AEFI: Hospitalization following COVID vaccination



Enhancements in Co-WIN Software

- A new feature of 'Allot beneficiary' in 'Ongoing session' added:
 - ✓ To allow maximum possible number of beneficiaries per session & have better coverage.
 - ✓ Pre-registered beneficiary in the database can be added to the session as additional beneficiary over & above the scheduled number of beneficiaries.
 - ✓ Person's name can be searched in the database by mobile number.
- Provisional certificate to be given after 1st dose & final certificate after 2nd dose.







Daily Review of Progress by DMs

- DMs and District Immunization Officers advised to hold daily review meetings with the Session Site I/c & Cold Chain Point I/c for:
 - Taking feedback about overall day's progress
 - Session planning & scheduling for forthcoming days/week
 - Regular reconciliation of vaccine stocks
 - Daily Training/Sensitization of stakeholders about latest instructions and refinements in software.
