OFFICE ORDER

Commissioner, Health & Family Welfare Services Vide Order No: DHS/DD/SSU/COVID-19/17/2019-2020 Dated 22/05/2020 has stipulated Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for entry of persons from other States to Karnataka.

Passengers have been classified into those returning from High Prevalence States (**as notified by Government of Karnataka from time to time) and those from Low Prevalence States.

** As on 22.5.2020 Maharashtra, Gujrat, Delhi, Tamil Nadu, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh.

Institutional Quarantine for a period of 7 Days has been mandated to all such returnees from High Prevalence States with certain exceptions and modifications for certain Class of Passengers which has been clearly spelt out in the aforementioned Order.

In the given situation, it is imperative to identify Hotels and decide rates for accommodating such Passengers who will be subject to Institutional Quarantine on Self Payment basis.

The following rates are hereby fixed for different Category of Hotels that will be housing Domestic Airline Passengers:-

A. 5 Star Hotels(Luxury)

- ✓ Rs.3000 per Person / Day inclusive of all Taxes and Breakfast (Rs.550 for Lunch & Rs.550 for Dinner would be charged in addition).
- ✓ Rs.3700 for Twin Occupancy inclusive of all Taxes and Breakfast (Rs.550 for Lunch & Rs.550 for Dinner per Person would be charged in addition).

B. 3 Star/4 Star (Mid-Range)

- ✓ Rs.1500 per Person /Day inclusive of all Taxes and Breakfast (Rs.175 for Lunch & Rs.175 for Dinner would be charged in addition).
- ✓ Rs.1750 for Twin Occupancy inclusive of all Taxes and Breakfast (Rs.175 for Lunch & Rs. 175 for Dinner per Person would be charged in addition).

C. Budget Hotels:

- ✓ Rs 1200 Per Person/ Day Inclusive of all Taxes and Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner.
- ✓ Rs 1400 for Twin Occupancy/Day inclusive of all Taxes and Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner.

Passengers may be informed about the Prevailing Rates for different Categories before they embark on the journey or during their travel so that they can be clear on the Category in which they wish to stay if they are to be put under Institutional Quarantine.

Passengers would have the liberty of selecting the Category of Stay but they will not have the choice of selecting any particular Hotel/ Hotel Group in a Category citing proximity to living place, company policy or his personal preferences.

Coloured Coupons will be provided to Passengers who will be put on Institutional Quarantine based on the Category of Hotel selected by them. Colour Code assigned to Hotels based on their Category.

Budget @ White, 3 Star (Mid-Range) @ Orange and 5 Star (Luxury) @ Green.

The Roaster for Operating the Hotels in different Categories is annexed with this Order reflecting the Name and Address of the Property and Number of Rooms available.

Zonal Joint Commissioners, BBMP shall be the Nodal Coordinating Officers for their respective Zones and shall deploy responsible Officers at KIAL who will inform the Hotel Management on the arrival of Passengers to the respective Hotels.


Joint Commissioners, BBMP shall also ensure that an Officer/ Employee (BBMP/District Administration) is stationed at the Hotel prior to the arrival of Passengers for Quarantine.

Deputy Commissioner, Police of the concerning Law & Order Zones shall ensure deployment of requisite Police Personnel in the Hotel (Institutional Quarantine Centre) before the arrival of Passengers for Quarantine and also ensure static stationing of Police Personnel in the Quarantine Centre for access control in the premises.

It is advisable to encourage Twin Occupancy in Hotels if Passengers are travelling alone based on their mutual consent in view of limited number of Hotel Rooms and for ensuring the sustainability of the arrangements.

Accommodation in the Hotels would be subject to availability of the Rooms in the particular category at that point of time and mere selection of category is no guarantee on the availability of the Rooms.
